An Educator's Professional Liability Insurance Program

Again this year TCCTA members may enroll in an optional \$2,000,000 educator's professional liability insurance program. The cost of the program is \$50. (Insurance is required for personal service of an attorney.) Major provisions of the policy include:

- *Professional liability coverage of \$2,000,000 per member*
- *Reimbursement of attorney's fees up to \$10,000*
- *Reimbursement of bail bond premium up to \$1,000*
- *Coverage for punitive damages up to \$5,000*

To enroll in the liability insurance plan, check the appropriate box on the membership enrollment form. Add the cost of the annual premium (\$50) to the amount of membership dues and attach your check. Coverage becomes effective upon receipt of the enrollment form and check. Coverage is valid to September 1, 2010.

Coverage under the Educator's Professional Liability Insurance Program is subject to the terms, conditions, limitations, and exclusions contained in the master policy on file with the Texas Community College Teachers Association.
